


Case Study: Morrisons Manufacturing Changing Rooms

Project:

To design, manufacture and install wash / changing room equipment at a large food production facility.





Unitech Engineering were awarded a contract by a food production facility owned by Morrisons Manufacturing Worsley to supply and install changing room facilities at their greater Manchester site.

We were tasked with equipping an area to provide a barrier between the low care changing area and high care changing, offering a more hygienic and organised method of storing outside shoes in a locker bench whilst also increasing the overall capacity by 33% on the wellington boot storage, offering both secure lockable as well as non secure racks. Equipment supplied included floor mounted welly racks, secure and non-secure, multipurpose PPE dispensers, garment lockers, garment collectors, apron roll dispensers, bespoke step over shoe storage barrier benches to fit between wall kerbs and vertical posts and full length polished mirrors.
